## Autoclave broken? Making funny noises? Here's what to do:

Call Getinge (1-800-660-1687) to report the problem and provide them the serial number.

## Tips & Tricks...

Biohazard waste from BSL-1 and BSL-2 labs may be disposed of directly into EHS-supplied Biohazard Waste Boxes lined with red biohazard bags. If your lab needs to autoclave waste, be sure to:

- Use a tray to contain your waste
- Use autoclavable biohazard bags
